GENERAL PRICE LIST

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. This list does not include prices for any items you may ask us to purchase on your behalf such as flowers, clergy honoraria, death certificates, obituaries, etc. The prices for these items will be shown on the Statement of Goods and Services Selected. In some cases we charge you for arranging these third party items.

These prices are effective as of January 1, 2019 and are subject to change without notice.

A.) PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF 2340

- Our services include: the arrangement conference; planning ceremonies; consulting with officiants; preparing & filing necessary notices; obtaining authorizations & permits; coordinating with cemetery, crematory or third parties. Included is a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs; clerical assistance, drafting & submitting obituaries, filing governmental forms, filing & securing death certificates, arranging military honors, procuring death benefits, postage, printing & supplies; telephone, internet & fax/scanning service; care / custody of the deceased, and delivery of equipment/supplies. Our basic charge covers support services following the funeral, including delivery of service-related items. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select.

EMBALMING 570

- Except in certain special cases embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. Our firm requires embalming if public viewing occurs during a published time segment.

OTHER PREPARATION OF THE BODY 385

- This includes cosmetics and restoration, dressing and positioning deceased in the casket. This fee applies when the body is un-embalmed and present at the funeral - for bathing, topical disinfection, and dressing or wrapping. **We reserve the right to decline cosmetology & dressing of un-embalmed decedents in unsanitary situations.**

Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are fiberboard. Our charge for direct cremation without ceremony includes transfer of the deceased, basic services of staff, placement of obituaries, securing death certificates, necessary authorizations, cremation and delivery of the urn.

Transfer from RDU Airport, basic staff services and transport to the cemetery with no time schedule and no ceremonies.

BURIAL SERVICES

This package includes the Services of funeral director and staff; embalming & other preparation; facilities & staff for receiving visitors and directing the funeral; transfer of the deceased into our care; hearse & floral transport.
- 2.) Graveside Funeral with Reception / Visitation 6435**
This package includes all the services in the preceding package with the funeral being held at the gravesite.
- 3.) Church or Chapel Funeral with Reception Same Day 6410**
This package includes all the services in a Church or Chapel funeral, with the reception being held the same day as the funeral.

CREMATION SERVICES

- 1.) Church or Chapel Funeral with Reception / Visitation 7275**
Services of funeral director and staff; embalming & other preparation; facilities & staff for receiving visitors and directing the funeral; transfer of the deceased into our care; hearse, floral transport and cremation following ceremonies. *Note: Hearse charge deducted if held in chapel.*
- 2.) Church or Chapel Funeral with Ceremonial Urn Ark 6320**
Services of funeral director and staff; facilities and staff for receiving visitors and directing funeral; transfer of deceased; floral transport and cremation. *Note: Hearse charge deducted if held in chapel.*
- 3.) Church or Chapel Memorial Service with Reception 5925**
Services of funeral director and staff; facilities and staff for receiving visitors; direction of memorial service; transfer of deceased; floral transport and cremation.
- 4.) Church or Chapel Memorial Service with Graveside Rites 5560**
Services in the preceding package without a separate visitation period and with graveside rites held either before or after the memorial service.
- 5.) Church or Chapel Memorial Service, or Graveside Service 5365**
Services for a memorial ceremony held in our chapel, one's place of worship or the gravesite.

- 6.) Memorial Gathering / Reception in Funeral Home 4255**
Services for a memorial gathering/reception in our facility and cremation.
